

ClickFilm[®] is a window film that can flexibly turn opaque windows and glazing into transparent glass surfaces at the touch of a button. This electrochromic film is suitable for retroinstallation to all flat glass surfaces and is many times more cost-effective than electrochromic glass.

ClickFilm[®] switches at the touch of a button from white matt (privacy protection) to transparent. This allows for many possible uses and applications in private residences, for example in bathrooms, bedrooms and living rooms, as well as in offices and conference rooms, for more privacy in meetings; it is also useful in catering establishments and laboratories.

Technical characteristics

One benefit of the liquid crystal film is that it has very low electricity consumption. Power is supplied from a transformer with 65 volts aternating voltage (tolerance +/- 5%). As soon as the low voltage is applied using the remote control, the film becomes transparent. When the voltage is interrupted, matt privacy protection is restored.

ClickFilm[®] is made to measure by HAVERKAMP and installed by trained, specialist personnel (excluding connection of electronic components). Alternatively, the film is also available as a ready product, including transformer, cables and remote control. ClickFilm[®] has a UV transmission of less than 1% (300-380 nm). The film should always be cleaned using cleaning agents recommended by HAVERKAMP.

ClickFilm[®] used as a projection surface

Because of the white color variation, the film is also ideal as a projection surface for photographs and other projected media in meetings and presentation rooms.
